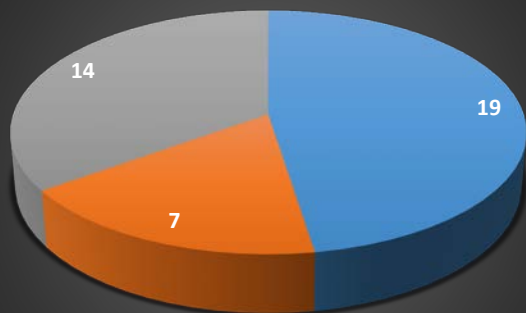

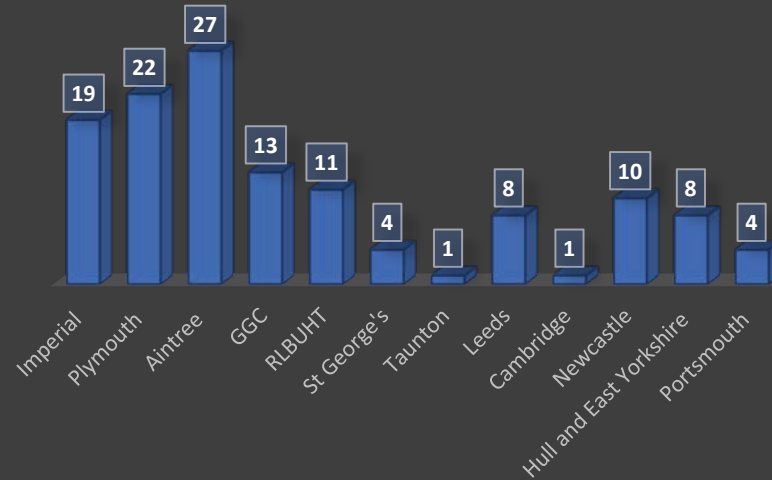

- Please do not collect whole blood samples on Fridays/Saturdays, as the Imperial College London laboratory is not available to receive the specimen during weekends
- Once the samples have been sent, please notify the MICAH team by emailing Tom Barbera [t.barbera@imperial.ac.uk](mailto:t.barbera@imperial.ac.uk) and Lily Cross [lily.cross@imperial.ac.uk](mailto:lily.cross@imperial.ac.uk). - Histology slides should be sent with an accompanying histology report however **please ensure all patient identifiable information is redacted.**
- Please package all whole blood samples according to the UN3373 regulations and arrange next day delivery. Samples must arrive at the central lab within 24hrs of collection
