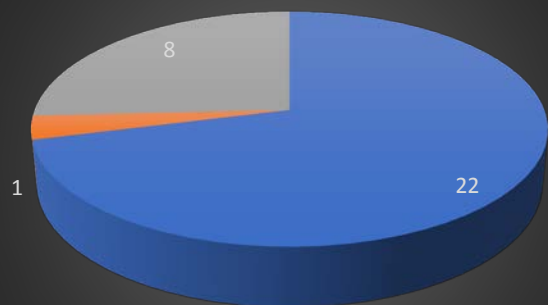

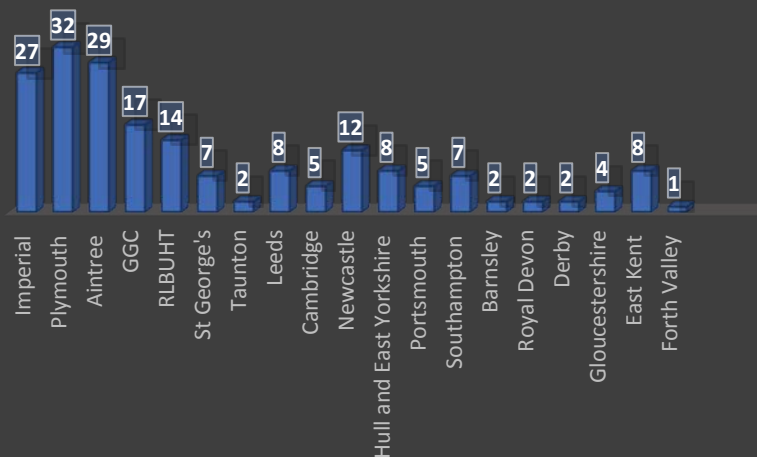

GENERAL UPDATES

- Imperial Clinical Trials Unit and Laboratory Christmas Closure: ICTU and the St Mary’s laboratory will be closed for the Christmas and New Year period from **Friday 24th December 2021** and will re-open on **Tuesday 4th January 2022**. Please do not send any research samples during this time.
- We will be sending out more TransFix and PBMC blood tubes to all recruiting sites just before the college closes for Christmas and New Year as we will not be available to send any during the time that we are closed.
- Monitoring visits will resume in the New Year and this will include on-site visits to enable appropriate source data verification checks to be carried out. We are aware of the ongoing situation with the rapidly growing numbers of the Omicron variant of corona virus and so we will be contacting all open sites to find out whether on-site monitoring can be accommodated at this time.
